Meeting was called to order at 7:37 a.m. Introductions were made.

Mantua Township: No report.

Mantua Village: No report.

Shalersville Township: The township ordered a new 1-ton dump truck and several other pieces of equipment. They have been using a \$50,000 grant received from First Energy.

Crestwood Schools: The first ever 8th grade trip to Washington D.C. is coming up. The community walking program hosted by the school and is being held on Wednesdays and Fridays (when school is open). An elementary school community breakfast is scheduled for February 22 at 7:30 a.m.

Announcements:

DMRC: They are researching grants that may now be available. They have 501(c)(3) status.

Truck Traffic Restriction: Carl Zeleznik talked about a petition that has been signed to restrict truck traffic on residential roads in Mantua Village. It has been suggested that trucks have been causing a noise issue, as well as damage to these roads. Carl said if trucks are not permitted to travel freely through the village, this will have a large negative impact on many of the local businesses that the operators use for fuel, food, parts, etc. Edie Benner motioned for the Chamber to schedule a meeting with the mayor to discuss this issue. Keith Barton seconded the motion.

Goodell Pancake Breakfasts: Virginia Goodell mentioned the Goodell Family Farm Pancake Breakfasts will be March 6, 13, and 20, from 8:30AM-2PM. The cost is \$7.50 for adults, \$4 for children 4-11 and those 3 and under dine for free.

Ohio State Girls Wrestling Tournament: Dean Olson announced that Crestwood will host the Ohio State Girls Wrestling Tournament again this year. It will be held on March 12th at 10AM in the Crestwood Middle School Gymnasium.

NOACC: Jim Prout talked about a special health insurance plan that is being made available through NOACC to people who have been without health coverage for six months or longer. Enrollees will be able to utilize services from physicians in the Summa Health System, will not have to pay a deductible, and will benefit from premiums that are a fraction of the cost of other health insurance policies.

Featured Business: Brent Simon from GoRilla Productions provides affordable web design services to local businesses. He is available to business owners to discuss website ideas. Brent showed the group various websites he has designed for local companies and organizations.
